Fourth of July at Willow Grove.

The Committee appointed to make arrangements for the celebration of the Fourth of July at Willow Grove, announced the following program:

At day-break, one gun fired, and revolve ball. At Sunrise, one gun fired, and flags hoisted. At 9 o'clock the procession will form under the direction of Michael Peter, Marshall, in front of Bateson's store, and will march through the village to the canopy erected for the occasion, where seats will be provided.

On Tuesday night last about 11 o'clock, our citizens were startled by the cry of fire; the heavens were lit up as though an extensive fire was raging in the west end of the town. A general rush was made to the spot. The male portion of the citizens turned out en-masse, and soon discovered that it was nothing but a barn, of comparatively little value, the property of Mrs. M. Read. The conflagration had evidently been the work of an incendiary who had set fire to the building for the purpose of gratifying his own civil prejudices.

One of the engines having been out the afternoon previous, perhaps prompted the evil deed, without any malice to the owner of the building. Although the value of the property destroyed, did not happen to be very great, yet who can estimate the amount of evils caused by this one act of some unprincipled wretch. Thousands of persons were alarmed, and hundreds aroused from their peaceful slumbers and hurried to the scene of disaster. The frightful thought to many, that there is in their midst one who may at any hour of the night, set fire to their dwelling, and the disgrace to the town, that there is such a wretch in it; are not these evils of no small magnitude? It is hoped, however, that the culprit may yet be detected and brought to justice.

The fact that our town is greatly in need of efficient fire organizations and apparatus, is evident to every eye, yet the matter is delayed, and perhaps will be until some sweeping conflagration destroys a large portion of our town. What is to prevent the destruction of much of the town should a fire break out in some thickly settled portion of it, of a windy night. Where is the efficient fire engine, hose and other apparatus to save it? Bridgeton is well furnished with gas, and the next desirable and important thing is water works, with all the appliances necessary to extinguish fires which will sooner or later break out here.

About 2 o'clock on Monday morning last there was another fire discovered in the wood-shed of Mr. Lawrence Thompson, of this town, which would perhaps had it not been extinguished before the flames spread, have caused much destruction of property. A young man who happened out rather late on Sunday night and "didn't go home till morning," passing by, discovered the flames and extinguished them before any damage was done. This fire originated from some coals in ashes placed in the wood shed some hours previous.
