INCOME TAX. The amended form of returns for the income tax has been received by the Assessors of Income Tax. The blank which every citizen is obliged to fill up covers all the ground, and unless a man purges himself, there can be no excuse. We give below the material part of the form, which sets forth a long array of questions requiring answers.

Ordinance No. 1. An Ordinance to prevent the running at large of Horses, Cattle, Swine, Sheep, Goats and Geese in the City of Bridgeton. Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Bridgeton, that it shall not be lawful for any person to run at large any horse, cattle, swine, sheep, goats or geese within the limits of the city, and all such found running at large shall be liable to be impounded.
