SIR HENRY VINCENT'S LECTURE.

The opening lecture of the season, before the Young Men's Christian Association of this city, was delivered by Sir Henry Vincent, the nobleman was not widely different from other men, but for the fact that he was a man of real merit in his profession, we doubt if the blood of the "Vincent" would have impressed particularly the Young America of Bridgeton, still it was something of a sensation to have a nobleman from England in our quiet city, and to doubt the fact contributed largely to the interest of the occasion.

AN EXTENSIVE BRICK-YARD. Those who have never witnessed the manufacture of brick on a large scale would find it interesting to visit the new and extensive yard of Isaac Mulford, in West Bridgeton, at the foot of Lincoln street, worthy their attention. A large amount of thirty or forty acres, known as the Brick-yard, lying along the west side of the creek, has been purchased by Messrs. H. J. & Isaac Mulford, and is being wonderfully improved within the last few months, that the place would scarcely be known by those who have not lately visited it. The swamp has been filled with thousands of cart loads of sand from the neighboring hills; a bank has been erected along the creek, the trees and underbrush removed, and a large cleared and suitable buildings erected thereon for the use of bricks on an extensive scale. There is also a large and complete supply of superior clay in sight of the Brick-yard, which is brought to the principal building and there prepared and put through a patent machine, which has turned out as many as thirty-two bricks per minute, or fifteen thousand a day. This is known as the Continental Brick Machine, and is the only one of the kind in the State, and is driven by a ten or twelve horse engine. The bricks are carried from this machine on a small cart running on a track, to the drying-house, which is capable of holding all that can be made in a day or two, and by that time they are sufficiently dry to move to the kiln, where they are put through a process of burning which is ready for use in a few days. It is the intention of the proprietor, in a short time, to commence the manufacture of pressed brick, in addition to red and salmon. The Brick-yard is owned by Isaac Mulford, although H. J. Mulford also deserves much credit for assisting in the improvement of that part of Bridgeton. Lincoln street is now being opened at the expense of Mr. Mulford, and will extend from Atlantic street to the creek. Atlantic street will be extended to Lincoln and when this is completed it will add very much to the value and appearance of that part of Bridgeton.

EVERY NEW ENTERPRISE in our city which has heretofore been purchased at a distance, is a benefit to this place, not only in furnishing an article which keeps the money here, but places it in circulation. When brick of as good a quality can be furnished at home for the same money they can be had elsewhere, the community should be acquainted with the fact, and no doubt in the future there will be more brick used in this city and surrounding country.
